BOARD MEETING FOR CANVASS AND CERTIFICATION OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING HELD ON APRIL 21, 2026

Chair Stirrup called the meeting to order at 12:05 PM on April 22nd in the conference room at the Office of Elections. As all three Board members were present, there was a quorum.

The purpose of the meeting was to hear from any voters who had been required to vote a provisional ballot on April 21st. One voter appeared and described his experience at the precinct. Secretary Scarborough explained that the Board would be meeting on Saturday to review all provisional ballots and the voter would receive a letter from the Elections Office informing him whether his provisional ballot had been counted.

Secretary Scarborough offered three motions: (1) to allow the election officers and staff to open the Envelope 2As and Envelopes 2s for the purpose of conducting the canvass; (2) to allow staff to open the Envelope 1s to conduct provisional research to prepare for the adjudication of provisional ballots; and (3) to authorize the delivery of the Envelope 3s and the Envelope 6s to deliver the ballots to the courthouse. The motions were seconded by Vice Chair Montgomery and passed unanimously.

The Board recessed at 12:25 PM for lunch.

At 1:05 PM, the Board moved to the Old Courthouse and Chair Stirrup called the Canvass Meeting to order. All three Board members were present. Chair Stirrup thanked the officers present and introduced General Registrar Olsen, who explained the steps to be followed to canvass the results of the special election for Congressional Redistricting.



General Registrar Olsen and the Election Office staff then distributed materials to six teams of officers, who commenced the canvass. The officers reviewed the documents and reported results for all precincts, including the Central Absentee Precinct (CAP).

The canvass was completed at 4:07 PM and the Board adjourned until April 25th at 9:00AM.

PROVISIONAL BALLOT ADJUDICATION

The Board reconvened at 9:00 AM on April 25th for the purpose of reviewing all provisional ballots cast in the special election. All three members were present.




Assistant Director Taylor led the review process. There were 1,472 provisional ballots completed during early voting and election day. The Board reviewed the circumstances of each provisional ballot and voted unanimously to count 1,361 of those ballots and not count the remaining 111 provisional ballots. The approved ballots were all counted and the results added to the ELECT website.

The Board conducted another review of all of the results tapes for all of the precincts to verify the numbers reported.

The Board recessed at 12:30PM for lunch and reconvened at 3PM.

The General Registrar prepared the final documents and the Abstract of Votes which was signed by all three Board members.

Having completed all of the steps in the canvass and certification, the Board adjourned at 3:15PM.
