## January 13, 2026 Special Election

### Election Basics

Election Day: January 13, 2026 (*Writ attached*)  
Early Voting: Saturday, January 3 – Saturday, January 10, 2026  
Hours: TBD by EB (staff recommends keeping standard EV hours, *attached*)  
PWC Certification: Saturday, January 17<sup>th</sup> (BOCS meets on January 20<sup>th</sup>, make request)  
Candidate Filing: Deadline of Wednesday, December 17

### Turnout Estimates: High-Turnout Model

Estimates for planning purposes only)

- Early Voting: ~1,600 voters
- Election Day: ~2,800 voters on Election Day (~200 per precinct)
- Mail Voting: ~500 voters (1,300 mail ballots on permanent absentee status)

### Training Plan

- Online Refresh for All Officers - January 6<sup>th</sup>
- Workshop: Allow officers that need to get hands on practice if desired
- Communicate with Chiefs that need performance improvements from reports

### Timelines

Mail Ballots – December 23<sup>rd</sup> mailing (must complete L&A beforehand)

- Expected arrival before Early Voting starts

Ballot Prep – Draft is done, just need candidates

- Names on 18<sup>th</sup>, submit to state for approval on 18<sup>th</sup>/19<sup>th</sup>

Task Planning – Will be condensed, but scope of everything is much smaller

- Board will be sent weekly updates starting December 19, 2025

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE ELECTORAL BOARDS OF PRINCE WILLIAM  
COUNTY AND STAFFORD COUNTY:

WHEREAS, a vacancy will occur in the Virginia House of Delegates during the 2026 Regular Session of the Virginia General Assembly from the Twenty-third House District, composed of part of Prince William County and part of Stafford County, occasioned by the resignation of the Honorable Candi Mundon King.

NOW THEREFORE, in the name of the Commonwealth, pursuant to the fact that the 2024 Special Session I remains ongoing, and pursuant §24.2-216 of the *Code of Virginia*, you are hereby required to cause an election to be held in this district on January 13, 2026, for a member of the House of Delegates to fill the vacancy. Pursuant to §24.2-507 and §24.2-510 of the *Code of Virginia*, the last day for filing as a candidate for such office in said election shall be Wednesday, December 17, 2025 at 5:00 p.m.
