### **BOARD MEETING FOR CANVASS AND CERTIFICATION OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR WOODBRIDGE DISTRICT SUPERVISOR HELD ON MARCH 10, 2026**

Chair Stirrup called the meeting to order at 11AM on March 11. As all three Board members were present, there was a quorum.

Chair Stirrup thanked the officers present and introduced General Registrar Olsen, who explained the steps to be followed to canvass the results of the special election for Woodbridge District Supervisor.

Chair Stirrup offered three motions: (1) to allow the election officers and staff to open the Envelope 2As and Envelopes 2s for the purpose of conducting the canvass; (2) to allow staff to open the Envelope 1s to conduct provisional research to prepare for the adjudication of provisional ballots; and (3) to authorize the delivery of the Envelope 3s and the Envelope 6s to deliver the ballots to the courthouse. The motions were seconded by Secretary Scarborough and passed unanimously.

General Registrar Olsen and the Election Office staff then distributed materials to three teams of officers, who commenced the canvass.

The General Registrar stated that any voters who came to the Office of Elections for the Provisional Voter Meeting at noon would be directed to the Old Manassas Courthouse. No voters appeared for that meeting.

The canvass was completed at 12:30PM and the Board adjourned until March 13<sup>th</sup>.

**PROVISIONAL BALLOT ADJUDICATION**

The Board reconvened at 2:02PM on March 13th for the purpose of reviewing all provisional ballots cast in the special election. All three members were present.

Assistant Director Taylor led the review process. There were 37 provisional ballots cast. The Board voted unanimously to count 34 of those ballots and not count the remaining 3 ballots. The approved ballots were all counted and the results added to the ELECT website.

The Board conducted another review of all of the results for all of the precincts to verify the numbers reported. The Board noted that there were a total of 825 Write-In votes. Pamela Montgomery received 809 of the valid write-in votes and there were 10 valid write-in votes for other persons.

The General Registrar prepared the final documents and the Abstract of Votes which was signed by all three Board members.

Having completed all of the steps in the canvass and certification, the Board adjourned at 3:45PM.
