


- 87 Precincts will have a Democrat Ballot <u>ONLY</u>



<u>Pg. 106 Poll Watchers</u> - They are concerned citizens and should be treated with kindness



- You cannot leave the precinct once you arrive


Book/Phone Use

- Put away when voters are present








Let's Talk About the Pollbook (Tablet to Check-In Voters)




- The Pollbook is the tablet that holds the registered voter list from the Virginia Department of Elections


Ballot Scanner

Note: Ballot can be submitted on either side

Scanner Officer Highlights



- You need to be behind the Scanner while voters are scanning ballots
- You should be able to see the "blue light"
- If a ballot gets rejected, you need to engage with the voter to determine the issue





"Ready for use" Screen

Officer Duties > Scanning Ballots




- The machine is ready to accept a ballot
- This is when a voter will scan their ballot


Rejected Reason #1 Blank Ballot (uncommon)

- Ask voter to read the screen to you, as you are not allowed to view a voter's ballot
- If the screen reads, "You made no choices on the ballot"
- Give voter the option of taking the ballot and marking it or pressing the "Cast ballot as-is" button




Rejected Reason #2 Overvote (uncommon)

- Ask voter to read the screen to you
- If the screen reads, "Too many choices are marked..."
- Give voter the option of taking the ballot to the Chief and getting a new one or pressing the "Cast ballot as-is" button



Rejected Reason #3 Ballot Error/Misfeed

- Ask voter to read the screen to you
- If the screen reads, "Your sheet did not scan"
- Have voter attempt to rescan ballot
- If the ballot does not scan, send the voter to the Chief to receive a new ballot




TOUCH WRITER Highlights



- The Touch Writer is our ADA marking device
- It is used for voters who have difficulties marking a ballot
- The CO, AO, or EPS will assist those voters
